

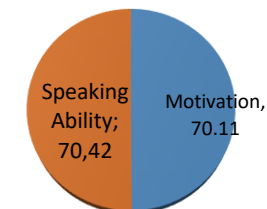

Result

It can be seen on the following diagram, it is shown that both variables are balance.



The Result of R-product moment is 0.98, and t-test is 24.5. The Hypothesis is Rejected. The contribution of speaking motivation to speaking ability is 96%, 4% influenced by the other factors. It means there is the significant relationship of speaking motivation of the students in Ma'had Al-Jami'ah and their speaking ability.

Discussion

What has been found by the researchers supported what have been done previously such as Dörnyei, 1998; Harida, 2017; Quadir, 2014; & Rahman, Multazim, Husna, & Hidayah, 2019). As stated by Maslow that the person who has high motivation will have high reason to get high result and reach what they have being done.

Conclusion

It seems that the students in Ma'had Al-Jami'ah IAIN Padangsidimpuan have high motivation to speak, and it influence their speaking ability. The hypothesis is accepted, there is the significant relationship between motivation and speaking ability. It is suggested that the English class in Ma'had Al-Jami'ah must be more interactive and increase in order to make IAIN Padangsidimpuan become a desired university.

Abstract

The objective of this study is to examine the first grade students of Ma'had Al-Jami'ah IAIN Padangsidimpuan in the relationship of motivation and their speaking ability. It has been done by using correlational method, with 495 students as the population, and the researcher decided to choose 26 students as the sample. Data have been collected by questionnaire for speaking motivation and spoken test for speaking ability that is taken by video recorded. To analyze the data, the researcher used product moment formula and t-test. After analyzing the data, the researcher found that mean score of students' speaking motivation was 72.11, and mean score of their speaking ability was 70.42. The result showed that there was correlation between two variables in very high category. Besides looking from the mean-score, the researcher also used product moment correlation, when r_{xy} was higher than r_{table} the hypothesis was accepted, meanwhile if it is lower, the hypothesis was rejected. In this research, it is found that r_{xy} was higher than r_{table} ($0.98 > 0.388$), with t-test $24.5 > t_{table}$ (0.515). It means the hypothesis (H_a) was accepted. It was concluded that there was a correlation between speaking motivation and speaking ability of the 1st semester students' Ma'had Al-Jami'ah IAIN Padangsidimpuan

Intro

To train the students to use foreign language, English and Arabic, IAIN Padangsidimpuan has a Ma'had Al-Jami'ah Program in which the students on the first year of their study must follow this. The students are trained to use English and Arabic in their daily life of boarding.

Speaking is one skill to be mastered in this program, because the students use it in their daily communication. They will give punishment if the do not use the language. Further, motivation is needed to support learning process, without having good motivation, the result of learning will not be satisfied. So, speaking will be more important for them in it.

2. To examine the students' speaking ability
3. To examine the relationship between both of them.

Methods

Correlational Method with 26 students as sample. Speaking Motivation and Speaking test as the instrument to take the data. R-Product moment is the way to analyze the data.

Result

The motivation of the students of Ma'had Al-Jami'ah in speaking is by the mean-score 72.11, while in speaking ability is 70.42, both of them in high category.
